BISHOP'S BULLETIN SEPTEMBER 2026

Dear friends,

Summer shifts into autumn and along comes a familiar ache within - that 'back to school' feeling, which is a mixture of fear, memory and longing. Whether we are making a fresh start or returning to the old familiar routine, the weeks before us mark the most poignant of seasons, as we give thanks for all that God has provided, and prepare the ground for what lies ahead.

A great comfort, then, to be reminded of the words of Jesus in St John's Gospel, assuring his friends that he goes ahead of them, to 'prepare a place'. This is the night before his death, which promises to open a way through even the deadliest barriers to life with God. Days later, the disciples hear the news that their risen Lord is 'going ahead of them into Galilee' – a familiar route, now transformed. This scriptural theme of Jesus as our 'pioneer', the one who goes before us, is a deep spiritual truth and extremely helpful to remember in daily life.

Whatever lies before you this autumn, I commend the habit of praying 'Go before me, Lord' as you enter each new situation or encounter. It is a small reminder of Christ's accompanying presence, and a means of entrusting our future to him, whatever it holds.
